## **DuPont Commits to Sustainable Goals**

Speaking at the Pew Center Conference in September, **DuPont** COO Dennis Reilley unveiled a number of environmental goals for the company, which is a **CARB** team member. Reilley outlined targets for decreasing emissions and energy use, as part of the company's long-term interest in sustainability (**DuPont** was the first company to volunteer under the **DOE** Environmental Protection Agency's Climate Wise program). Specifically, Reilley outlined three goals: to reduce **DuPont's** greenhouse gas emissions by 65% (using 1990 as a base year); hold total energy use flat (with 1990 as a base year); and sourcing 10% of the company's global energy use in the year 2010 from renewable resources.
